## INCLUSIONS

- **Accommodation** - All days stay at hotels, camps or guest houses on Single/double or triple sharing basis, as selected
- **Meals** - Breakfast and dinner are included in the trip from Dinner on Day 01 to Breakfast on Day 06
- **Transportation** – Bike as per selection and fuel as per the itinerary. If bringing your own bike, then the fuel cost will not be included in the package cost.
- **Experienced Tour marshal with Mechanic**
- **Helmets** for both Rider and Pillion (used ones-not new)
- **Backup Vehicle** with Facility to carry luggage in a vehicle restricted to 1 Rucksack / Duffle bag of 60 Litres per motorbike
- **A Professional Tour Guide** with experience of accompanying travellers on trips to this location is provided throughout the trip
- **Miscellaneous**

## ITINERARY

### DAY 1 : ARRIVAL IN LEH

Arrive in Leh and spend the day acclimatizing. Overnight stay in Leh.

### DAY 2 : Leh Local

Prepare for a local sightseeing tour in Leh. Visit Magnetic Hill, Gurudwara Pathar Sahib Gurudwara, Hall of Fame, Monastery, Shanti Stupa, Leh Palace, and Sangam Confluence. Dinner and overnight stay at the Hotel. Get ready for the long-awaited adventurous trip and prepare accordingly. Visit Leh market in the evening. Stay overnight in Leh.

### DAY 3 : LEH TO NUBRA VALLEY

Prepare to ride through the world's second highest motorable road and enter the beautiful Nubra Valley. The trail crosses places such as South Pullu , Khardung La - 18,380 ft, and North Pullu.. Following the permit check post, enter Khalsar, a small village on the banks of the Shyok River, with Hunder Sand Dunes, Camel Rides, and ATV rides. Spend the night in Nubra.

### DAY 4 : NUBRA VALLEY TO PANGONG TSO

After breakfast, enjoy the drive to Pangong Tso, perhaps one of the most picturesque places in Ladakh. The route will mostly follow the Shyok river. Stops along the way include Agham, a tiny village where the road cuts for Wari La (enroute Leh), Located at the intersection of Pangong Tso and Chang La roads, is the checkpoint for Tangste. This is the last checkpoint before Pangong Tso. The overnight stay is at Pangong Tso.

### DAY 5 : PANGONG TSO TO LEH

Explore the scenic Pangong Tso on a chilly morning. An early departure will permit visits to Shey Monastery and Three Idiots School. The group will see places like Tsoltak where a halt is scheduled, The climb for Chang La ( at 17,590 ft, it is the 2nd highest pass in the world) starts at here. Overnight stay at Leh.

### DAY 6 : DEPART FROM LEH

This day marks the end of this adventure. While you may be leaving for home today, you won't be going alone. This trip will provide you with lots of fun memories which you will treasure for a long time.
