INCLUSIONS

- **Accommodation** - All days stay at hotels, camps or guest houses on Single/double or triple sharing basis, as selected
- **Meals** - Breakfast and dinner are included in the trip from Dinner on Day 01 to Breakfast on Day 07
- **Transportation** – Bike as per selection and fuel for the entire itinerary. **(If bringing your own bike, then the fuel cost will not be included in the package cost.)**
- **Experienced Tour marshal with Mechanic**
- **Helmets** for both Rider and Pillion (used ones-not new)
- **Backup Vehicle** with Facility to carry luggage in a vehicle restricted to 1 Rucksack / Duffle bag of 60 Litres per motorbike
- **A Professional Tour Guide** with experience of accompanying travellers on trips to this location is provided throughout the trip
- **Miscellaneous**
 - First Aid Kit
 - Oxygen Cylinder
 - Inner line permit/Manali Green Tribunal Permit
 - Bonfire wherever applicable depends on weather conditions

EXCLUSIONS

- **Personal Expenses** such as telephone charges, laundry, tips, table drinks etc

- **Transportation charges** (airfare or rail fare) that are not mentioned in 'Inclusions'

ITINERARY

DAY 1 : ARRIVAL IN LEH

Arrive in Leh and spend the day acclimatizing.
Overnight stay in Leh.

DAY 2 : Leh Local

Prepare for a local sightseeing tour in Leh.
Visit Magnetic Hill, Gurudwara Pathar Sahib, Hall of Fame, Monastery, Shanti Stupa, Leh Palace, and Sangam Confluence. Dinner and overnight stay at the Hotel. Get ready for this long-awaited adventurous trip and prepare accordingly. Visit Leh market in the evening. Stay overnight in Leh.

DAY 3 : LEH TO NUBRA VALLEY

Prepare to ride through the world's second highest motorable road and enter the beautiful Nubra Valley. The trail crosses places such as Khardung La - 18,380 ft, and North Pullu, where lunch is served. Following the permit check post, enter Khalsar. This is a small village on the banks of the Shyok River, with Hunder Sand Dunes, Camel Rides, and ATV rides. Spend the night in Nubra.

Day 4 : Nubra To Siachen/ Turtuk To Nubra

This is the time to turn up the adventure at 'The Great Siachen Base Camp' excursion. The Base Camp is positioned at a height of 12000ft above sea level. Siachen is home to the world's highest battlefield. The trip will take 8 hours and cover almost 120km. Stay at Nubra overnight.

Day 5 : Nubra Valley To Pangong Lake

Leaving the barren region behind, the group will move toward the pristine Pangong Lake. The route passes through Shyok Village, which opened to tourists only recently. Upon reaching the shores of this enchanting waterbody, marvel at its beauty and tranquillity, and take a few photographs. Next, head to the campsite for a bonfire and a serene overnight stay.

Day 6 : Pangong To Leh

Wake up to the sight of the scenic Pangong Tso on a chilly morning. An early departure will permit visits to Shey Monastery and Three Idiots School. The group will see places like Tsoltak where a halt is scheduled. The climb for Chang La (at 17,590 ft, it is the 2nd highest pass in the world) starts at a small lake. Lunch will be served at Karu/Shakti. Overnight stay at Leh.

Day 7 : DEPART FROM LEH

Today is the last day of this adventure. Even though you're leaving for home today, you won't be going alone. The memories you will make on this trip will last a lifetime.
