INCLUSIONS

- **Accommodation** - All days stay at hotels, camps or guest houses on Single/double or triple sharing basis, as selected
- **Meals** - Breakfast and dinner are included in the trip from Dinner on Day 01 to Breakfast on Day 10
- **Transportation** – Bike as per selection and fuel for the entire itinerary
- **Experienced Tour marshal with Mechanic**
- **Helmets** for both Rider and Pillion (used ones-not new)
- **Backup Vehicle** with Facility to carry luggage in a vehicle restricted to 1 Rucksack / Duffle bag of 60 Liters per motorbike
- **A Professional Tour Guide** with experience of accompanying travellers on trips to this location is provided throughout the trip

ITINERARY

Day 1 : Arrive Manali-Local Sight Seeing & Briefing

Upon arrival at Manali, check into the hotel and relax today to become acclimatized. Visit local sites in Manali today.

The tour captain will give you a brief overview of the ride, the itinerary, bike distribution, etc. Enjoy a leisurely evening. Overnight stay at the hotel with dinner.

Day 2 : Manali To Jispa/ Sarchu

The long-awaited journey to Ladakh has begun. Prepare yourself for a thrilling ride. The route takes you through Atal tunnel, Tandi (last petrol pump before Upshi) and Keylong. The group will be accommodated in the camps at Jispa / Sarchu after arrival.

Day 3 : Jispa / Sarchu To Leh

Today, gear up for a difficult journey. The journey will include driving across Zing Zing Bar, Suraj Tal, Baralacha La-16040 ft., and Killing Sarai. Upon arriving at your destination, stay in camps and have a hearty dinner.

Day 4 : Leh To Nubra Valley

In this section of the Srinagar To Manali Motorbike Expedition, road travel takes you to the Nubra Valley via a scenic and thrilling journey. The road to the valley crosses Khardung La, reputed to be the world's highest motorable road. The hotel located on the banks of the Nubra River in Nubra Valley is the perfect place for a relaxing overnight stay.

Day 5 : Nubra To Siachen/ Turtuk To Nubra

At 'The Great Siachen Base Camp' Excursion, experience adventure at its very best. Base Camp is located at an altitude of 12000 ft above sea level. Siachen is the highest battlefield in the world. Stay in Nubra for the night.

Day 6 : Nubra Valley To Pangong Lake

This morning leave behind the bleak landscape of the stark region and move towards the pristine Pangong Lake. The road will take you through the newly opened Shyok Village. When you reach the shores of this enchanted water body, you will be amazed by its beauty, tranquility, and vivid colors. Next, transfer to the campsite for a bonfire and an evening of relaxation surrounded by nature.

Day 7 : Pangong To Leh

The Pangong Tso offers a scenic view. Breakfast will be served before leaving for Leh. Cross Chang La (17,590 ft), the second highest pass of the world. The pass is considered one of the toughest in the world. Leh and the Changthang Plateau are connected by this pass. There is a small lake called Tsoltak that the group can witness prior to climbing the Mighty Pass. There will be a descent into Shakti after crossing the pass, and the journey continues towards the Manali-Leh Highway. Upon arrival in Leh, experience the city and spend the night there.

Day 8 : Leh To Kargil

Today the expedition will head toward Kargil. Enroute cross Fotu La (13,480ft), which is the highest in the region in terms of altitude. Visit the Buddhist Monastery of Lamayuru on the way. Our next stop will be Hambuting La Mountain Pass, followed by a descent to the lovely town of Kargil. Overnight stay at the hotel.

Day 9 : Kargil To Srinagar

After a healthy breakfast, the expedition to Ladakh will begin. Witness one of the most picturesque passes in the region, the Zojila Pass. A short break will be taken before moving ahead to Srinagar via the breath-taking Sonamarg Valley. The next destination is Srinagar, the capital of Jammu and Kashmir. Visit Shalimar Bagh and enjoy Shikara Riding On Dal Lake. Spend the night near the lake.
