INCLUSIONS

- **Accommodation** – (10 Nights and 11 Days) All days stay at hotels, camps or guest houses on double or triple sharing basis, as selected
- **Meals** - Breakfast and dinner are included in the trip from Dinner on Day 01 to Breakfast on Day 11
- **Transportation** – Bike as per selection and fuel for the entire itinerary
- **Experienced Tour marshal with Mechanic**
- **Helmets** for both Rider and Pillion (used ones-not new)
- **Backup Vehicle** with Facility to carry luggage in a vehicle restricted to 1 Rucksack / Duffle bag of 60 Liters per motorbike
- **A Professional Tour Guide** with experience of accompanying travellers on trips to this location is provided throughout the trip
- **Miscellaneous**
 - First Aid Kit
 - Oxygen Cylinder

ITINERARY

Day 1 : Arrive Manali & Briefing

After arriving in Manali (6730 ft), check in to the hotel and relax to become acclimatized to the high altitude. Explore local sights in Manali. A brief introduction to the ride, the itinerary, and the bike allocation will be provided by the Tour Captain. Enjoy some leisure time in the evening. Stay overnight in the hotel and enjoy dinner.

Day 2: Manali to Sarchu | 250kms | 10,500 ft

The long-awaited journey to Ladakh will begin on day 2. Get ready for an unforgettable journey. On the way, cross the Atal tunnel, Tandi (the last gas station before Upshi, and Keylong). Camps will be available for overnight stays in Sarchu.

Day 3: Sarchu to Leh | 350 kms | 13,780 ft

Today, gear up for a difficult journey. The journey will include driving across Zing Zing Bar, Suraj Tal, Baralacha La-16040 ft., and Killing Sarai. Upon arriving at destination, stay in the Hotel and have a hearty dinner.

Day 4: Leh to Nubra Valley | 160 Km | 3-4 Hrs | 17,982 ft

The adventurous trip from Leh to Nubra Valley commences today. This part of our travel package is all about scenic and thrill-filled rides from Leh to Nubra Valley, where you will experience the adrenaline rush of riding on one of the highest motorable roads in the world – Khardung La. After reaching Nubra Valley, which is located on the banks of the tranquil Nubra River, we will pause and unwind in the hotel.

Day 5: Nubra Valley to Pangong Lake | 150 Km | 3-4 Hrs | 14,270 ft

This morning leave behind the bleak landscape of the stark region and move towards the pristine Pangong Lake. The road will take you through the newly opened Shyok Village. When you reach the shores of this enchanted water body, you will be amazed by its beauty, tranquillity, and vivid colors. Next, transfer to the campsite for a bonfire and an evening of relaxation surrounded by nature.

Day 6: Pangong to Hanle | 312 Kms | 7 hrs | 14,764 ft

Today is all about traversing the distance from Pangong to Hanle, an off-beat route added to make this Leh tour package special. We will ride from Pangong to Hanle post breakfast, and then, even the air will say that you have come a long way. The immaculate waters of Pangong lake will still be a part of our journey - pegged to leave us spellbound as we ride alongside its shore. We will cross Merek Village and then Chushul. Riding further on the Loma bridge, we will move towards Hanle - a beauty-inducing historic village that hosts the highest astronomical observatory in the world. Not to mention, this ravishing place is one of the restricted areas in Ladakh - open to only domestic tourists with permits. We will check in to the guest house and give in to the comfort of a modest but cozy stay.

Day 7: Hanle - Umling La Pass- Hanle

Today will be a memorable day. Get ready to experience the adventure as we embark on a soul-stirring gospel ride via one of the highest motorable passes in the world - Umling La pass (19300 ft.). A thrilling route added especially to this Leh package - this one will have you enraptured for months to come. Many of you might be checking it off your bucket list during our stay in the guest house tonight.

Day 8: Hanle to Tso Moriri | 130 kms | 4-5 hrs

Have your breakfast, and we'll be meeting at the ever-so-quiet Tso Moriri Lake. On our way, we will cross Ya Ya Tso Lake, Nurpa Pass (16,100 ft.), and Mahe Bridge. We will reach Korzok by late afternoon, after which the time will be all yours to try and grasp the symphonies of the Tso Moriri Lake. We will wrap this day up at a hotel or camp in Korzok.

Day 9: Tso Moriri To Leh | 260 kms | 8-9 Hrs

Let's have our breakfast early today and leave for our next quest. The notes at the end of any Leh packages are often the ones we either want to delay or delete! But we are not going alone this time. There are memories of the divine Ladakh which will never fade. We will cross Puga, the wonder valley that is famous for its hot sulphur spring, and we will pass by the gorgeous Tso Kar - an emerald Salt Lake that can make anyone believe in magic. We will also come across Taglang La La Pass (17,585ft.), the highest motorable road on Manali Leh Highway. We will reach Leh by the evening and give it a rest with a stay at the hotel here.

Day 10: Leh to Sarchu | 250 kms | 13783ft.

In the morning, after a hearty breakfast, continue your journey into Sarchu/ Jispa. Take in the panoramic view of the mighty mountains and colors of nature as you travel through the mountains of Jammu and Kashmir And Himachal Pradesh.

Ascend Tanglang La, the third highest pass (17,480 ft). Pass through the Morey-Plains, an astounding plateau at a height of 15,500 ft with a 45 km stretch of flat road. After crossing Lachung La (16,616 ft) and Nakee La (15,547 ft), reach the famous Gata Loops (21 hairpin bends). After that, you will reach your destination by nightfall.

Day 11: Sarchu to Manali Drop | 200 kms | 10,500 ft.

Get ready for the last day of the Manali – Leh- Umling la -Motorbike Expedition as soon as the dawn breaks. Following a hearty breakfast, Ride along the iconic route of the Atal Tunnel and some of the most scenic villages in the Lahaul Valley.

This day marks the end of this adventure. While you may be leaving for home today, you won't be going alone. This trip will provide you with lots of fun memories which you will treasure for a long time.
