

INCLUSIONS

- Accommodation All days stay at hotels, camps or guest houses on Single/double or triple sharing basis, as selected
- **Meals** Breakfast and Dinner is included on all days except breakfast on Day 1 and dinner on day 7 of the trip
- Transportation Airport transfers by MUVs/Vans from airport taxi union. Additionally, All sightseeing as per itinerary by exclusive NAC MUV (Innova/Xylo/similar) upto 06 pax and by NAC Tempo Traveller (12-seater) from 07 pax onwards
 - Complementary world's longest high altitude Zipline ride (short stage) at DH Adventure Park in Nubra Valley.

ITINERARY

Day 01: Arrive Leh.

Arrive Leh airport, wisdom Representative will meet, assist, and transfer the guests to the hotel in Leh. Rest of the day free to acclimatize to the high altitude of Ladakh. In the evening you may take a **walk to the local market**, but we highly recommend giving complete rest to the body. Overnight stay at Leh.

Day 02: Excursion to Sham Valley till Sangam (within 70 Kms).

Day start with Hall of Fame, which was constructed by the Indian Army to commemorate the sacrifice of soldiers during Indo-Pak wars. Mahakal Temple and Spituk Gompa - an 11th century structure, Next on the list of attractions is the majestic Gurudwara Patthar Sahib. Nestled deep in the Himalayas, it was constructed by the Lamas of Leh in 1517 to honour the visit of Guru Nanak Dev - the founder of the Sikh faith. Drive another few km to witness the magic of Magnetic Hill that defies the law of gravity. It has been noticed that when a vehicle is parked on neutral gear on this metallic road, it seems to slide up and further. Driving through a picturesque landscape, we reach the confluence of the Indus and Zanskar River (Sangam). Return to hotel via same route. In the evening, you may take a walk around the beautiful town and explore the local flavors it offers to the visitor.

Day 03: Leh - Nubra Valley (120 Kms | 4-5 hrs approx)

After Breakfast drive to Nubra Valley via **Khardungla** (Highest Motorable road in the world, 18,380 ft). On the way visit **Desert Himalaya Adventure Park** where you can have lunch and enjoy adventure activities like **World's longest High-Altitude Zip line** and **ATV ride** at **Khalsar sand dunes** (activities on direct payment basis) Arrive at your destination and check in to the hotel/camp. Later visit 108 ft high **Maitriya Buddha Statue** at **Diskit monastery** and **Hunder Sand Dunes** where you can enjoy **double humped camel** ride (on direct payment basis) Return to your resort/camp for overnight stay.

Day 04 : Nubra - Leh

Morning after Breakfast proceed for Leh, once again driving via Khardungla pass the World Highest Motorable road. Evening free to stroll around **Leh bazaar** for souvenir, visit **Leh Jokhang** or **Leh Mosque** by foot. Return to hotel for overnight stay at the hotel.

Day 05: Day excursion to Pangong Lake (280 kms / 08 hrs round trip)

After Breakfast leave for **Pangong Lake** (14,500 ft) through the **Indus River Valley**. A beautiful drive of appox 04 hours and you'll be at one of the most beautiful places of the planet. Spend some time around the lake visit the **03 Idiot shooting point**, try local food at any of the small restaurant around the Lake shore. Post lunch start your drive to Leh crossing the mighty **Changla pass at 17000ft** once again. Arrive Leh on time for dinner. Overnight stay at the hotel in Leh.

Day 06: Indus Valley Monastery Tour. (90 Kms round trip)

After breakfast leave for Indus Valley monastery tour starting from **Shey Palace** on a hillock 15 Kms upstream from Leh, it was once the residence of the royal family. A 7.5 mts high copper statue of Buddha, plated with gold and the largest of its kind, is installed here. A drive of another 05 kms will bring us to **Thiksey Monastery** which is one of the largest and architecturally most impressive Gompas of Ladakh. There are several temples in this Gompas, containing images, stupas, and wall paintings of Buddha, which are exquisite. Finally, we drive to **Hemis**, appox 40 Kms from Leh, it is the wealthiest, best known and biggest Gompa of Ladakh. Hemis was built in 1630 and is divided into two parts, the assembly hall on the right and the main temple on the left... After visiting Hemis drive back to Leh. Enroute two brief halts at Druk Pema Karpo School AKA **Rancho's School** (03 Idiot fame) and **Sindhu Ghaat** where the annual Sindhu Darshan festival is held. Reach Leh and relax at the hotel or just walk to Leh market for any last-minute souvenir shopping. Overnight stay at the hotel in Leh.

Day 07: Leh Airport Drop

Early morning transfer to Leh airport to board flight back to destination.
