ITINERARY

Day 1: Arrival in Leh

Drive to your hotel in Leh. Spend the day relaxing and getting used to the weather. Overnight stay in Leh.

Day 2: Leh - Nubra Valley 160 Kms | 2-3 Hrs | 17,982 ft

Embark on the beautiful journey to the stunning Nubra Valley. You will also climb Khardung La situated at a height of 17,982 feet, also the highest motorable road of the world. Enjoy your lunch at North Pullu. Enjoy a short break at Khalsar, a village situated on the banks of river Shyok and Hunder.

Overnight stay at Nubra.

Day 3: Nubra - Turtuk - Nubra 160 kms one way | 2-3 hrs | 10,000 ft

Day three begins with a delectable breakfast before embarking on a ride towards Turtuk village. This charming town is the last outpost in India before the Pakistan-controlled Gilgit-Baltistan begins and serves as a gateway to the Siachen Glacier. Turtuk is culturally, linguistically, and historically different from anything you've experienced thus far in your Ladakh holiday, as it falls under the Gilgit-Baltistan region. The landscape is also unique with narrow valleys and steep mountains, unlike Central Ladakh and Nubra. Despite being situated at a lower altitude than Leh, you'll be amazed by the green pastures that yield fresh produce like apricots and apples.

The picturesque journey from Turtuk to Leh takes you through some of the most stunning landscapes in the world. The route from Turtuk to Leh winds its way through the rugged terrain of the Himalayan mountains, promising breathtaking views at every turn. As we make your way from Turtuk to Leh, we'll pass through remote villages and ancient monasteries that are steeped in history and culture. One of the highlights of the trip from Turtuk to Leh is the chance to meet the locals and learn about their way of life. The people in this region are warm and welcoming, and they will make you feel right at home.

Relish the stunning natural beauty of the landscape on your journey from Turtuk to Leh. The snow-capped mountains, crystal-clear rivers, and verdant valleys are a visual treat. After a day of exploration, return to the Nubra Valley campsite for a delicious dinner and spend the night under the starry sky.

Day 4: Nubra Valley - Pangong Lake 150 Kms | 3-4 Hrs | 14,270 ft

Today, you will leave from the surreal Nubra towards the pristine Pangong Lake. Enroute, you will pass through the quaint and picturesque Shyok Village, nestled on the banks of river Shyok. Soak in the serenity and beauty of this waterbody.

Later in the day, transfer to the campsite for a relaxed bonfire.

Overnight stay at the Pangong Valley.

Day 5: Pangong - Leh 160 Kms | 5-6 Hrs | 17,590 ft

Enjoy the beautiful and chilly morning at the scenic Pangong Tso. Leave early to visit the school from the movie '3 Idiots' and Shey Monastery. Shey Monastery is known for its giant copper with gilded gold statue of Shakyamuni Buddha, believed to be the second-largest statue in Ladakh.

You will also see places like Tso Ltak, the unexplored lake of Ladakh where the climb for Chang La starts.

Enjoy lunch at Karu/Shakti. Overnight stay in Leh.

Day 6: Depart from Leh

After breakfast, leave for the airport. Transfers to the airport will be provided.
