ITINERARY

Day 01: Drive from Cochin to Munnar (140 km / 4 Hours)

Start your Kerala tour with Eravikulam National Park. Witness the endangered Nilgiri Tahr and the breathtaking views of the astounding South Indian mountain peaks. Then, move on to Anamudi Peak. The peak will give you some of the most thrilling views of South India. Be sure to visit the scenic and always picturesque lakeside Mattuppetty.

In the afternoon, visit the tea museum. It will take you on a tea time travel trip,

and you can also savour some tea there. Move on to check out the Blossom Hydel park and take a stroll around the beautiful and serene park. Next, visit the aromatic and lovely-looking spice plantation before ending the sightseeing tour with a visit to the Bee Nest. The fragrance of the spices will immerse you in the flavours of Kerala. Be sure to taste the honey and see how nature's engineers work.

Return to the homely accommodation after the long day.

Day 02: Munnar sightseeing

After having breakfast, start your thrilling sightseeing journey to the beautiful Keralian hill station, Munnar.

Check out Echo Point first. The place presents a panoramic view of the hill station, and you will also witness natural echo. The view from Echo Point is also splendid. Move on to Gundala Lake, famous for its serene atmosphere and

exquisite boating experience.

In the afternoon, check out the beautiful Elephant Arrival Point. Here, you will be able to witness the elephant movement and gain insights into the cultural significance of the place. Move on to the Cinema Shooting Point, located in a scenic backdrop, which is a delight for film buffs. End the day of sightseeing after visiting the Jungle Honeybee Nest, where you will enjoy natural wonders and get a chance to sample honey.

If you wish to enjoy the rugged terrain of Munnar, you can also choose to add on an offbeat jeep safari and gain a unique perspective of the hill station. In the evening, return to your accommodation for an overnight stay.



Day 03: Drive from Munnar to Thekkady (110 km / 3 Hours)

In the morning, after you are done with an enriching breakfast, get ready to start another beautiful journey towards Thekkady. It is one of the country's most significant and best-kept wildlife reserves.

Enter the Periyar Natural Life Asylum, a 777 sq km range covered with evergreen woods for a stretch of 360 sq km. Not only does the place abound in wildlife, but also various tree species.

We will organise discretionary exercises like boating on the Periyar Lake, visiting the spice plantation, or taking an elephant ride. However, all these activities come with additional expenses.

In the evening, return to the resort and stay overnight.

Day 04: Drive from Thekkady to Alleppey (160 km / 4 Hours)

We start our day with an enriching breakfast and head straight to Alleppey. After checking in to the hotel, get ready to experience one of the most brilliant tour experiences, a houseboat experience in the Alleppey backwaters.

Cruising through the marvellous and serene environment and relinquishing local delicacies will immerse you in the majesty of Mother Nature. In the evening, return to your resort and spend time with your friends and families, cherishing the beautiful memories of the Kerala trip.

Day 05 Drive from Alleppey to Kovalam(160Km/4 Hours)

Start your trip in the morning from the beautiful, picturesque, and tranquil Alleppey towards the sandy shores and marvellous-looking beach town of Kovalam.

After reaching Kovalam, we will organise fun beachside activities like sunbathing, swimming, and homegrown body rubs. However, if you wish to have some thrills, scuba diving awaits you, or you can also challenge the waves with your kayak. These are purchasable as add-ons. These things will be followed by social ventures and a sailboat adventure.

In the evening, check in to the beautiful resort at Kovalam and spend the evening relinquishing the excellent memories made throughout the day.



Day 06: Kovalam To Kanyakumari excursion

Have an early breakfast today since a long 100 km journey awaits. The destination is Kanyakumari, the southernmost tip of India, which is around 3 hrs away from Kovalam.

The very first location that we will visit is the Padmanabhapuram Palace. It is an architectural marvel and hosts some exquisite collections of arms, armoury, furniture, and other items of the Travancore royal family. We will then move on to Suchindram temple. The temple is dedicated to lord Vishnu and is also famous for its elephant procession.

In the afternoon, we visit the Devi Kanyakumari Temple, which is one of the most scenic locations in Kanyakumari and is dedicated to Goddess Parvati. The temple is followed by the most revered and famous Vivekanada Rock and Memorial, which is one of the most stunning monuments with a picturesque view in the background, accompanied by a serene atmosphere.

We complete today's day with a visit to Gandhidham, a picturesque beach known for its relaxing atmosphere, and Triveni Sangam, one of the most significant Hindu religious places that hold pristine beauty.

After enjoying the beachside sunset, return to the exquisite stay at Kovalam.

Day 7 Kovalam To Trivandrum

This is the last day in God's Own Country.
