## INCLUSIONS

- **Accommodation** - All days stay at hotels, camps, or guest houses on Single/double or triple sharing basis, as selected.
- **Meals** - Breakfast and dinner are included in the trip from Dinner on Day 01 to Breakfast on Day 09.
- **Transportation** – Bike as per selection and fuel for the entire itinerary. **(If bringing your own bike, then fuel cost will not be included in the package).**
- Experienced Tour marshal with Mechanic.
- **Helmets** for both Rider and Pillion.
- **Backup Vehicle** with Facility to carry luggage in a vehicle restricted to 1 Rucksack / Duffle bag of 60 Litres per motorbike.
- **A Professional Tour Guide** with experience of accompanying travellers on trips to this location is provided throughout the trip.
- First Aid Kit.
- Oxygen Cylinder.
- Inner line permit/Manali Green Tribunal Permit.
- Bonfire wherever applicable depends on weather conditions.

## EXCLUSIONS

- **Personal Expenses** such as telephone charges, laundry, tips, table drinks etc.
- **Insurance of any kind** - Medical, Accidental or theft.
- **Transportation charges** (airfare or rail fare) that are not mentioned in 'Inclusions'.
- **Lunch** or any other meal not listed in 'Inclusions'.
- **Parking and Entry fees** for sightseeing.
- **Activities outside of bike expedition.**
- Cost of any spare part which will be used due to the accidental damage incurred when the motorbike is in riders' possession.
- Cost incurred to transfer or tow the motorbike in case the trip is discontinued mid-way.

## ITINERARY

### Day 1: Arrival in Chandigarh

After reaching the hotel in Chandigarh, meet the crew members and fellow travellers. After a detailed briefing on the tour, the bikes will be assigned. Stay and Dinner at the hotel.

### Day 2: Chandigarh to Narkanda/ Rampur

After breakfast, begin your journey to Spiti. Stunning views of Chail, Kufri, and Hatu Peak enroute. Overnight stay in hotel/home Stay. Enjoy a warm dinner.

### Day 3: Narkanda/ Rampur to Chitkul/ Sangla

After breakfast, depart for one of the most beautiful views of Kinnaur Valley. The village is the last inhabited one before the border between India and China. Stay and Dinner at Hotel/Homestay.

### Day 4: Chitkul/ Sangla to Kalpa

After breakfast head to Kalpa, which is just 60 Kms away, and reach Kalpa by afternoon. Overnight stay at Camp/Homestay

### Day 5: Kalpa to Kaza

Depart for Kaza after breakfast. Enroute Indo-Tibet highway. Also, on the itinerary is the KhabConfluence of the Satluj River and Spiti River. Afterwards, cross Nako and enter Spiti valley right after crossing Sumdo. Stop at Nako Lake for lunch. Take a detour from here to visit the 500Year-Old Mummy in the Gue Village. Head to Kaza for dinner and overnight stay.

### Day 6: Kaza to Hikkim – Komik – Langza Sightseeing

After breakfast, ride your bike to see the breath-taking beauty of Kaza. The small village Langza of Spiti Valley contains some of the most attractive tourist attractions such as Key Gompa Monastery which is nestled between mountains in a bowl-shaped formation. The village is located at an astounding 14,500 ft above sea level. Moreover, it is the highest village in the world with a motorable road; Komik is the highest village with a motorable road. The village of Hikkim in Spiti District, near Kaza, is another beautiful location. Stay overnight at a hotel.

**Day 7: Kaza to Kunzum La to Chandratal/ Sissu**

Our motorbike excursion then moves to the beautiful crescent shaped Chandratal Lake, the next location on the map. This place will take your breath away. There are parking facilities two kms away from the lake. There is a lake in the Spiti region of Lahaul and Spiti district that is also known as "Moon Lake." On one side, it is surrounded by mountains and on the other by a cirque. Seeing the sunset is a sight to behold. Spend the night in a camp under the stars.

**Day 8: Chandratal/ Sissu to Manali**

The ride from Spiti to Manali will begin today. By evening, reach Manali via Rohtang Pass. After you check into the hotel, your bikes will be returned, ending your motorbiking trip. Overnight stay at the hotel

**Day 9: Manali to Chandigarh**

The ride today starts after breakfast in Manali and ends in Chandigarh in the evening. End of Spiti Road Trip Expedition.
