ITINERARY

DAY 1: Delhi to Amritsar

Check in at Amritsar hotel for acclimatization and briefing by tour captain. Enjoy a leisure evening with dinner and overnight stay included.

Day 2: Amritsar to Jammu | 200 km | 4-5 hrs

Begin your journey from Amritsar to Jammu, the winter capital of Jammu and Kashmir.

Traverse through the Himalayan foothills passing by Gurdaspur known for guru nanak ji's last days. En route witness the picturesque Pakistan Ravi river.

Day 3: Jammu to Srinagar | 270 Kms | 5-6 hrs

Breakfast then journeys from Jammu to Srinagar.

Witness majestic Jhelum River view enroute.

Pass through scenic Jawahar tunnel, admire mountain beauty.

Day 4: Srinagar to Kargil | 200 kms

Explore Ladakh's scenic beauty enroute to Kargil, passing through sonmarg's picturesque landscapes.

Experience high-altitude points like zoji La at 11,750 ft and dras, among the world's coldest inhabited places.

Visit the poignant Kargil war memorial a tribute to the 1999 conflict concluding the day's adventure.

Day 5: Kargil to Leh | 200 kms

Depart from Leh the trip's main attraction.

Experience panoramic views at Namika La (12,139ft) and Fotu La (13,478 ft.)

Capture stunning landscapes from memorable photos.

Day 6: Rest in Leh 40- 60 kms

Explore Leh's iconic attractions: Leh Palace, Shey Palaces, Shanti stupa, Gurdwara Pathar Sahib, Hall of fame Sangam and Magnetic Hill. Enjoy a day sightseeing and immerse yourself in local markets for shopping.

Take some well-deserved rest after a day full of exploration and excitement.

Day 7: Leh to Nubra Valley | 140 Km | 4-5 hours

Traverse the high- altitude roads to reach Nubra valley, passing through Khardung La at 18,380 ft. Pause at North Pullu Permit check-Post for lunch and visit Khalsar village along the Shyok river. Engage in thrilling desert activities like camel rides and ATV adventures amidst hunder's captivating dunes.

Day 8: Nubra to Pangong TSO

Depart after breakfast for Pangong TSO. Explore agham and Wari La pass. Lunch break at Durbok; Scenic bike ride along Shyok river.

Day 9: Pangong TSO to Leh

Explore pangong Tso's beauty in the morning and sightseeing including Changla Pass. Conclude the day with a satisfying lunch.

Day 10: Leh to Sarchu | 250 kms

Departure from Leh to Sarchu after breakfast. Marvel at high-altitude landmarks like Tanglang La, More Plains, Lachulung La, Nakee La. Experience the breathtaking Gata Loops with 21 hairpin bends. Enjoy scenic views and refreshing winds as Leh bids farewell.

Day 11: Sarchu to Manali

Departure to Manali. Enroute, pass through Baralacha La (16,040 ft.) the first Himachal pass after Leh. Visit Jispa, marking the start of the tree-line zone.

Explore Rohtang La (13,050 ft) gateway to the kullu valley.

Day 12: Manali to Chandigarh

Journey towards the plains heading to Chandigarh. Arrive in Chandigarh by evening. Explore towns along the way, including Manali a significant town in Himachal Pradesh.

Visit Bilaspur, Known for Gobind Sagar Lake, en route to Chandigarh.

Day 13: Chandigarh to Delhi

Departure from Chandigarh or Delhi. Reflect on cherished memories created during the ladakh journey.
