## ITINERARY

### Day 1: Arrival in Leh

- Drive to the hotel in Leh and spend the rest of the day relaxing and getting acclimatized.
- You will also meet the tour representative who will walk you through the tour.
- Overnight stay in Leh.

### Day 2: Leh Sightseeing

- Spend the day doing local sightseeing and exploring some fabulous places in Leh. Enjoy a lovely breakfast post that, visit the gravity-defying Magnetic hill, famous for the interesting optical illusion that it creates. You will also see the Shanti Stupa, Gurudwara Pathar Sahib, Leh Palace, Monastery and the Hall of Fame are dedicated to the Indian soldiers.
- The highlight of your day is the Sangam confluence where two rivers converge, offering you a unique experience. Later in the evening, visit the Leh market.
- Overnight stay in Leh.

### Day 3: Leh to Nubra Valley

- After breakfast, head to the awe-inspiring Nubra Valley. A broad valley with majestic mountains on all sides, Nubra is famous for its beautiful orchards, picturesque vistas, camels, and monasteries.
- On your way to Nubra Valley, you will cross Khardung La, the highest motorable road in the world.
- After crossing the checkpoint at North Pullu, you will also get a halt at Khalsar, a small village on the banks of rivers Shyok and Hunder. You will love the sand dunes alongside the Shyok River.
- Overnight stay at Nubra.

### Day 4: Nubra Valley to Turtuk and back

- Wake up to the beautiful view and the chilly morning at Nubra and enjoy a lovely breakfast. Turn on your adventurous side at the Turtuk Excursion. Overnight at Nubra.

**Day 5: Nubra Valley to Pangong Tso**

- Enjoy your breakfast at Nubra. Post breakfast leave for Pangong Tso, one of the most attractive places in Ladakh.
- Your drive to the Pangong Tso will be mainly alongside the Shyok River.
- Enjoy a halt at Agham and stretch your legs. Agham is a tiny village where the road cuts for Wari La, a mountain pass at an elevation of 17,427 ft above sea level.
- Enjoy your lunch at village Durbok where the road cuts for Chang La and Pangong Tso.
- Overnight stay at Pangong Tso.

**Day 6: Pangong Tso to Leh**

- Wake up to a beautiful, fresh, and chilly morning with a stunning view of the Pangong Tso and enjoy breakfast.
- Leave early to visit the Shey Monastery, also called Gompa. Housed on a hillock in Shey, it contains a huge Shakyamuni Buddha statue. Shey used to be the summer capital of Ladakh in the past.
- Also, visit the school from the movie '3 Idiots'. On the way back, you will see places like Tso Ltak, a beautiful high-altitude lake at 16,618 feet. Also, the climb for Chang La starts from here.
- Reach Leh in the evening. Overnight stay at Leh.

**Day 7: Departure from Leh**

- This is the last day of this adventure-filled trip. After breakfast, you will get a drop-off to the airport. Enjoy your journey back home.
